Riley Mantor, farmer, was born in Albany Co., NY June 22nd 1824 , and was quite small when his parents removed to PA. His early life and education are described in the sketch above. He began when a mere youth to work at carriage making, and followed this occupation until he came to MN. Arriving here permanently in 1854 – having visited the county in company with his elder brother in 1853. He took up land and opened a farm on section 17 where he now resides. He was partner in the saw and grist mill and store referred to above(in Peters bio), for which he hewed most of the timbers. He was a charter member of the Masonic Lodge, which he was instrumental in organizing, and which he has served most of the time as secretary. He is an active temperance worker, and in religious faith is a universalist. Beliving in the principle of public policy advocated by the republican party, he has always adhered to that organization. He has held various town offices, and served two years as register of deeds. In 1847, he was married t Leah Brooks, (*doesn't match above application*), a native of Crawford County, who died here May 23, 1875. She was a sister of the first Mrs. Peter Mantor.
